- Snowblower has been prepped for summer storage.
- The facility is still in shutdown/winter mode, but I am getting it ready to open up.

Cummins Backup Generator

- Monthly and weekly inspection and maintenance completed.
- The drive belt we replaced seems to be working well.

CONSIDERATIONS

- We will have to consider new pumps for some of the year-round residents in the spring.
- Two of the three aerators were rebuilt. The third was shot and he wasn't able to rebuild it, so we will have to get another new one, or just run with three this summer.
- The shafts have bearings that should be replaced as well.
