- Wade Trim received 6 E-One service requests during August.
- There were 3 Miss Dig utility location requests during the month.

STRATEGIC PLANNING

E-One risers have been ordered and will be installed when they arrive.

MAINTENANCE

- Weekly lagoon inspections completed.
- Lagoon aerators are operating well. We have switched to using only one aerator in each cell to lower electric costs while maintaining proper Dissolved Oxygen (DO) levels needed for proper treatment. In addition, the operation of aerators will be alternated weekly to insure both even mixing and wear of the components.
- Summer lagoon pest control (duck weed and algae) is ongoing.
- Weed removal around the lagoons is ongoing.

Cummins Backup Generator

Monthly and weekly inspection and maintenance completed.

CONSIDERATIONS

E-One: Replacement pump for one of the catastrophic failures last month.

OTHER NOTEWORTHY EVENTS OR ACTIVITIES

- The removal of downed trees will be completed by Paul soon.
- Fence repairs are ongoing.
